**9Then you will call, and the LORD will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I. “If you do away with the yoke of oppression, with the pointing finger and malicious talk,
10and if you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will rise in the darkness, and your night will become like the noonday.**

11The Lord will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-

scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail.

12Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age-old foundations; you will be called **Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings.**

13“If you keep your feet from breaking the Sabbath and from doing as you please on my holy day, if you call the Sabbath a delight and the LORD’s holy day honorable, and if you honor it by not going your own way and not doing as you please or speaking idle words,

14then you will find your joy in the Lord, and I will cause you to ride in triumph on the heights of the land and to feast on the inheritance of your father Jacob.”

Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.

Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning.

The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

And the great dragon was thrown

down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

But I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ.

PROPHECY**EZEKIEL 38**

1The word of the LORD came to me:

2“Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshek and Tubal; prophesy against him

3and say: ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am against you, Gog, chief prince of Meshek and Tubal.

4I will turn you around, put hooks in your jaws and bring you out with your whole army—your horses, your horsemen fully armed, and a great horde with large and small shields, all of them brandishing their swords.

5Persia, Cush and Put will be with them, all with shields and helmets,

6also Gomer with all its troops, and Beth Togarmah from the far north with all its troops—the many nations with you.

7“Get ready; be prepared, you and all the hordes gathered about you, and take command of them.

8After many days you will be called to arms. In future years you will invade a land that has recovered from war, whose people were gathered from many nations to the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate. They had been brought out from the nations, and now all of them live in safety.

9You and all your troops and the many nations with you will go up,

advancing like a storm; you will be like a cloud covering the land.

10“**This is what the Sovereign LORD says: On that day thoughts will come into your mind and you will devise an evil scheme.**

11**You will say, “I will invade a land of unwalled villages; I will attack a peaceful and unsuspecting people—all of them living without walls and without gates and bars.**

12**I will plunder and loot and turn my hand against the resettled ruins and the people gathered from the nations, rich in livestock and goods, living at the center of the land.”**

13**Sheba and Dedan and the**

merchants of Tarshish and all her villages will say to you, “Have you come to plunder? Have you gathered your hordes to loot, to carry off silver and gold, to take away livestock and goods and to seize much plunder?”’

14“Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say to Gog: ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: In that day, when my people Israel are living in safety, will you not take notice of it?

15You will come from your place in the far north, you and many nations with you, all of them riding on horses, a great horde, a mighty army.

16You will advance against my people Israel like a cloud that covers the land. In days to come, Gog, I will

bring you against my land, so that the nations may know me when I am proved holy through you before their eyes.

17“This is what the Sovereign LORD says: You are the one I spoke of in former days by my servants the prophets of Israel. At that time they prophesied for years that I would bring you against them.

18This is what will happen in that day: When Gog attacks the land of Israel, my hot anger will be aroused, declares the Sovereign LORD.

19In my zeal and fiery wrath I declare that at that time there shall be a great earthquake in the land of Israel.

20The fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the beasts of the field, every creature that moves along the ground, and all the people on the face of the earth will tremble at my presence. The mountains will be overturned, the cliffs will crumble and every wall will fall to the ground.

21I will summon a sword against Gog on all my mountains, declares the Sovereign LORD. Every man's sword will be against his brother.

22I will execute judgment on him with plague and bloodshed; I will pour down torrents of rain, hailstones and burning sulfur on him and on his troops and on the many nations with him.

23And so I will show my greatness and my holiness, and I will make myself known in the sight of many nations. Then they will know that I am the LORD.'

EZEKIEL 39

1"Son of man, prophesy against Gog and say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am against you, Gog, chief prince of Meshek and Tubal.

2I will turn you around and drag you along. I will bring you from the far north and send you against the mountains of Israel.

3Then I will strike your bow from your left hand and make your arrows drop from your right hand.

4On the mountains of Israel you will fall, you and all your troops and the nations with you. I will give you as food to all kinds of carrion birds and to the wild animals.

5You will fall in the open field, for I have spoken, declares the Sovereign LORD.

6I will send fire on Magog and on those who live in safety in the coastlands, and they will know that I am the LORD.

7“I will make known my holy name among my people Israel. I will no longer let my holy name be profaned, and the nations will know that I the LORD am the Holy One in Israel.

8It is coming! It will surely take

place, declares the Sovereign LORD. This is the day I have spoken of.

9“Then those who live in the towns of Israel will go out and use the weapons for fuel and burn them up—the small and large shields, the bows and arrows, the war clubs and spears. For seven years they will use them for fuel.

10They will not need to gather wood from the fields or cut it from the forests, because they will use the weapons for fuel. And they will plunder those who plundered them and loot those who looted them, declares the Sovereign LORD.

11“On that day I will give Gog a burial place in Israel, in the valley of

those who travel east of the Sea. It will block the way of travelers, because Gog and all his hordes will be buried there. So it will be called the Valley of Hamon Gog.

12“For seven months the Israelites will be burying them in order to cleanse the land.

13All the people of the land will bury them, and the day I display my glory will be a memorable day for them, declares the Sovereign LORD.

14People will be continually employed in cleansing the land. They will spread out across the land and, along with others, they will bury any bodies that are lying on the ground.

“After the seven months they will

carry out a more detailed search.

15As they go through the land, anyone who sees a human bone will leave a marker beside it until the grave diggers bury it in the Valley of Hamon Gog,

16near a town called Hamonah. And so they will cleanse the land.'

17“Son of man, this is what the Sovereign LORD says: Call out to every kind of bird and all the wild animals: ‘Assemble and come together from all around to the sacrifice I am preparing for you, the great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel. There you will eat flesh and drink blood.

18You will eat the flesh of mighty

men and drink the blood of the princes of the earth as if they were rams and lambs, goats and bulls—all of them fattened animals from Bashan.

19At the sacrifice I am preparing for you, you will eat fat till you are gluttoned and drink blood till you are drunk.

20At my table you will eat your fill of horses and riders, mighty men and soldiers of every kind,' declares the Sovereign LORD.

21"I will display my glory among the nations, and all the nations will see the punishment I inflict and the hand I lay on them.

22From that day forward the people

of Israel will know that I am the LORD their God.

23And the nations will know that the people of Israel went into exile for their sin, because they were unfaithful to me. So I hid my face from them and handed them over to their enemies, and they all fell by the sword.

24I dealt with them according to their uncleanness and their offenses, and I hid my face from them.

25“Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will now restore the fortunes of Jacob and will have compassion on all the people of Israel, and I will be zealous for my holy name.

26 They will forget their shame and all the unfaithfulness they showed toward me when they lived in safety in their land with no one to make them afraid.

27 When I have brought them back from the nations and have gathered them from the countries of their enemies, I will be proved holy through them in the sight of many nations.

28 Then they will know that I am the LORD their God, for though I sent them into exile among the nations, I will gather them to their own land, not leaving any behind.

29 I will no longer hide my face from them, for I will pour out my Spirit on

the people of Israel, declares the Sovereign LORD.”

DANIEL 11

1And in the first year of Darius the Mede, I took my stand to support and protect him.)

THE KINGS OF THE SOUTH AND THE NORTH

2“Now then, I tell you the truth: Three more kings will arise in Persia, and then a fourth, who will be far richer than all the others. When he has gained power by his wealth, he will stir up everyone against the kingdom of Greece.

3Then a mighty king will arise, who will rule with great power and do as he pleases.

4After he has arisen, his empire will be broken up and parceled out toward the four winds of heaven. It will not go to his descendants, nor will it have the power he exercised, because his empire will be uprooted and given to others.

5“The king of the South will become strong, but one of his commanders will become even stronger than he and will rule his own kingdom with great power.

6After some years, they will become allies. The daughter of the king of the South will go to the king of the North to make an alliance, but she will not retain her power, and he and his power will not last. In those days she

will be betrayed, together with her royal escort and her father and the one who supported her.

7“One from her family line will arise to take her place. He will attack the forces of the king of the North and enter his fortress; he will fight against them and be victorious.

8He will also seize their gods, their metal images and their valuable articles of silver and gold and carry them off to Egypt. For some years he will leave the king of the North alone.

9Then the king of the North will invade the realm of the king of the South but will retreat to his own country.

10His sons will prepare for war and

assemble a great army, which will sweep on like an irresistible flood and carry the battle as far as his fortress.

11“Then the king of the South will march out in a rage and fight against the king of the North, who will raise a large army, but it will be defeated.

12When the army is carried off, the king of the South will be filled with pride and will slaughter many thousands, yet he will not remain triumphant.

13For the king of the North will muster another army, larger than the first; and after several years, he will advance with a huge army fully equipped.

14“In those times many will rise against the king of the South. Those who are violent among your own people will rebel in fulfillment of the vision, but without success.

15Then the king of the North will come and build up siege ramps and will capture a fortified city. The forces of the South will be powerless to resist; even their best troops will not have the strength to stand.

16The invader will do as he pleases; no one will be able to stand against him. He will establish himself in the Beautiful Land and will have the power to destroy it.

17He will determine to come with the might of his entire kingdom and will

make an alliance with the king of the South. And he will give him a daughter in marriage in order to overthrow the kingdom, but his plans will not succeed or help him.

18 Then he will turn his attention to the coast lands and will take many of them, but a commander will put an end to his insolence and will turn his insolence back on him.

19 After this, he will turn back toward the fortresses of his own country but will stumble and fall, to be seen no more.

20 “His successor will send out a tax collector to maintain the royal splendor. In a few years, however, he will be destroyed, yet not in anger or

in battle.

21“He will be succeeded by a contemptible person who has not been given the honor of royalty. He will invade the kingdom when its people feel secure, and he will seize it through intrigue.

22Then an overwhelming army will be swept away before him; both it and a prince of the covenant will be destroyed.

23After coming to an agreement with him, he will act deceitfully, and with only a few people he will rise to power.

24When the richest provinces feel secure, he will invade them and will achieve what neither his fathers nor

his forefathers did. He will distribute plunder, loot and wealth among his followers. He will plot the overthrow of fortresses—but only for a time.

25“With a large army he will stir up his strength and courage against the king of the South. The king of the South will wage war with a large and very powerful army, but he will not be able to stand because of the plots devised against him.

26Those who eat from the king’s provisions will try to destroy him; his army will be swept away, and many will fall in battle.

27The two kings, with their hearts bent on evil, will sit at the same table and lie to each other, but to no avail,

because an end will still come at the appointed time.

28The king of the North will return to his own country with great wealth, but his heart will be set against the holy covenant. He will take action against it and then return to his own country.

29“At the appointed time he will invade the South again, but this time the outcome will be different from what it was before.

30Ships of the western coast lands will oppose him, and he will lose heart. Then he will turn back and vent his fury against the holy covenant. He will return and show favor to those who forsake the holy

covenant.

31“His armed forces will rise up to desecrate the temple fortress and will abolish the daily sacrifice. Then they will set up the abomination that causes desolation.

32With flattery he will corrupt those who have violated the covenant, but the people who know their God will firmly resist him.

33“Those who are wise will instruct many, though for a time they will fall by the sword or be burned or captured or plundered.

34When they fall, they will receive a little help, and many who are not sincere will join them.

35 Some of the wise will stumble, so that they may be refined, purified and made spotless until the time of the end, for it will still come at the appointed time.

THE KING WHO EXALTS HIMSELF

36 “The king will do as he pleases. He will exalt and magnify himself above every god and will say unheard-of things against the God of gods. He will be successful until the time of wrath is completed, for what has been determined must take place.

37 He will show no regard for the gods of his ancestors or for the one desired by women, nor will he regard any god, but will exalt himself above them all.

38 Instead of them, he will honor a god of fortresses; a god unknown to his ancestors he will honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and costly gifts.

39 He will attack the mightiest fortresses with the help of a foreign god and will greatly honor those who acknowledge him. He will make them rulers over many people and will distribute the land at a price.

40 “At the time of the end the king of the South will engage him in battle, and the king of the North will storm out against him with chariots and cavalry and a great fleet of ships. He will invade many countries and sweep through them like a flood.

41 He will also invade the Beautiful Land. Many countries will fall, but Edom, Moab and the leaders of Ammon will be delivered from his hand.

42 He will extend his power over many countries; Egypt will not escape.

43 He will gain control of the treasures of gold and silver and all the riches of Egypt, with the Libyans and Cushites in submission.

44 But reports from the east and the north will alarm him, and he will set out in a great rage to destroy and annihilate many.

45 He will pitch his royal tents between the seas at the beautiful

holy mountain. Yet he will come to his end, and no one will help him.

DANIEL 12

THE END TIMES

1“At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered.

2Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake: some to everlasting life, others to shame and everlasting contempt.

3Those who are wise will shine like

the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever.

4But you, Daniel, roll up and seal the words of the scroll until the time of the end. Many will go here and there to increase knowledge.”

5Then I, Daniel, looked, and there before me stood two others, one on this bank of the river and one on the opposite bank.

6One of them said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, “How long will it be before these astonishing things are fulfilled?”

7The man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, lifted his right hand and his left hand toward heaven, and I heard him swear by him who lives forever, saying, “It will be for a time, times and half a time. When the power of the holy people has been finally broken, all these things will be completed.”

8I heard, but I did not understand. So I asked, “My lord, what will the outcome of all this be?”

9He replied, “Go your way, Daniel, because the words are rolled up and sealed until the time of the end.

10Many will be purified, made spotless and refined, but the wicked

will continue to be wicked. None of the wicked will understand, but those who are wise will understand.

11“From the time that the daily sacrifice is abolished and the abomination that causes desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days.

12Blessed is the one who waits for and reaches the end of the 1,335 days.

13“As for you, go your way till the end. You will rest, and then at the end of the days you will rise to receive your allotted inheritance.”

JOEL 2

**1Blow the trumpet in Zion;
sound the alarm on my holy hill.**

**Let all who live in the land tremble,
for the day of the Lord is coming.**

It is close at hand—

**2a day of darkness and gloom,
a day of clouds and blackness.**

**Like dawn spreading across the
mountains a large and mighty army
comes, such as never was in ancient
times nor ever will be in ages to
come.**

**3Before them fire devours, behind
them a flame blazes. Before them the
land is like the garden of Eden,
behind them, a desert waste—
nothing escapes them.**

**4They have the appearance of
horses; they gallop along like cavalry.**

5With a noise like that of chariots
they leap over the mountaintops,
like a crackling fire consuming
stubble, like a mighty army drawn up
for battle.

6At the sight of them, nations are in
anguish; every face turns pale.

7They charge like warriors;
they scale walls like soldiers.

**They all march in line, not swerving
from their course.**

8They do not jostle each other;
each marches straight ahead.

**They plunge through defenses
without breaking ranks.**

9They rush upon the city; they run
along the wall. They climb into the
houses; like thieves they enter

through the windows.

10 Before them the earth shakes, the heavens tremble, the sun and moon are darkened, and the stars no longer shine.

11 The LORD thunders at the head of his army; his forces are beyond number, and mighty is the army that obeys his command. The day of the LORD is great; it is dreadful. Who can endure it?

REND YOUR HEART

12 “Even now,” declares the LORD, “return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning.”

13 Rend your heart and not your

garments. Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

14Who knows? He may turn and relent and leave behind a blessing— grain offerings and drink offerings for the LORD your God.

15Blow the trumpet in Zion, declare a holy fast, call a sacred assembly.

16Gather the people, consecrate the assembly; bring together the elders, gather the children, those nursing at the breast. Let the bridegroom leave his room and the bride her chamber.

17Let the priests, who minister before the LORD, weep between the

**portico and the altar. Let them say,
“Spare your people, LORD. Do not
make your inheritance an object of
scorn, a byword among the nations.**

**Why should they say among the
peoples, ‘Where is their God?’”**

THE LORD’S ANSWER

**18Then the LORD was jealous for his
land and took pity on his people.**

**19The LORD replied to them: “I am
sending you grain, new wine and
olive oil, enough to satisfy you fully;
never again will I make you an object
of scorn to the nations.**

**20“I will drive the northern horde far
from you, pushing it into a parched
and barren land; its eastern ranks
will drown in the Dead Sea and its**

western ranks in the Mediterranean Sea. And its stench will go up; its smell will rise.” Surely he has done great things!

21 Do not be afraid, land of Judah; be glad and rejoice. Surely the LORD has done great things!

22 Do not be afraid, you wild animals, for the pastures in the wilderness are becoming green. The trees are bearing their fruit; the fig tree and the vine yield their riches.

23 Be glad, people of Zion, rejoice in the LORD your God, for he has given you the autumn rains because he is faithful. He sends you abundant showers, both autumn and spring rains, as before.

24 The threshing floors will be filled

with grain; the vats will overflow with new wine and oil.

25“I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten—the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm my great army that I sent among you.

26You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the LORD your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed.

27Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the LORD your God, and that there is no other; never again will my people be shamed.

THE DAY OF THE LORD

28“And afterward, I will pour out my

Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

29Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days.

30I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke.

31The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.

32And everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved; for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be deliverance, as the LORD

has said, even among the survivors whom the LORD calls.

JOEL 3

THE NATIONS JUDGED

1“In those days and at that time, when I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem,

2I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel, because they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land.

3They cast lots for my people and traded boys for prostitutes; they sold girls for wine to drink.

4“Now what have you against me, Tyre and Sidon and all you regions of Philistia? Are you repaying me for something I have done? If you are paying me back, I will swiftly and speedily return on your own heads what you have done.

5For you took my silver and my gold and carried off my finest treasures to your temples.

6You sold the people of Judah and Jerusalem to the Greeks, that you might send them far from their homeland.

7“See, I am going to rouse them out of the places to which you sold them, and I will return on your own heads

what you have done.

8I will sell your sons and daughters to the people of Judah, and they will sell them to the Sabeans, a nation far away.” The LORD has spoken.

**9Proclaim this among the nations:
Prepare for war! Rouse the warriors!
Let all the fighting men draw near
and attack.**

**10Beat your plowshares into swords
and your pruning hooks into spears.
Let the weakling say, “I am strong!”**

**11Come quickly, all you nations from
every side, and assemble there. Bring
down your warriors, LORD!**

**12“Let the nations be roused; let
them advance into the Valley of
Jehoshaphat, for there I will sit to**

judge all the nations on every side.

13 Swing the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, trample the grapes, for the wine-press is full and the vats overflow—so great is their wickedness!”

14 Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.

15 The sun and moon will be darkened, and the stars no longer shine.

16 The LORD will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem; the earth and the heavens will tremble. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Israel.

BLESSINGS FOR GOD'S PEOPLE

17“Then you will know that I, the LORD your God, dwell in Zion, my holy hill. Jerusalem will be holy; never again will foreigners invade her.

18“In that day the mountains will drip new wine, and the hills will flow with milk; all the ravines of Judah will run with water. A fountain will flow out of the LORD's house and will water the valley of acacias.

19But Egypt will be desolate, Edom a desert waste, because of violence done to the people of Judah, in whose land they shed innocent blood.

20Judah will be inhabited forever

and Jerusalem through all generations.

21 Shall I leave their innocent blood unavenged? No, I will not.”

REVELATION 13

THE BEAST OUT OF THE SEA

1 The dragon stood on the shore of the sea. And I saw a beast coming out of the sea. It had ten horns and seven heads, with ten crowns on its horns, and on each head a blasphemous name.

2 The beast I saw resembled a leopard, but had feet like those of a bear and a mouth like that of a lion. The dragon gave the beast his power and his throne and great authority.

3One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed. The whole world was filled with wonder and followed the beast.

4People worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast, and they also worshiped the beast and asked, “Who is like the beast? Who can wage war against it?”

5The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise its authority for forty-two months.

6It opened its mouth to blaspheme God, and to slander his name and his dwelling place and those who live in

heaven.

7It was given power to wage war against God's holy people and to conquer them. And it was given authority over every tribe, people, language and nation.

8All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world.

9Whoever has ears, let them hear.

10“If anyone is to go into captivity, into captivity they will go. If anyone is to be killed with the sword, with the sword they will be killed.” This calls for patient endurance and

faithfulness on the part of God's people.

THE BEAST OUT OF THE EARTH

11 Then I saw a second beast, coming out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb, but it spoke like a dragon.

12 It exercised all the authority of the first beast on its behalf, and made the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose fatal wound had been healed.

13 And it performed great signs, even causing fire to come down from heaven to the earth in full view of the people.

14 Because of the signs it was given power to perform on behalf of the first beast, it deceived the

inhabitants of the earth. It ordered them to set up an image in honor of the beast who was wounded by the sword and yet lived.

15The second beast was given power to give breath to the image of the first beast, so that the image could speak and cause all who refused to worship the image to be killed.

16It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads,

17so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name.

18 This calls for wisdom. Let the person who has insight calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man. That number is 666.

REVELATION 16

THE SEVEN BOWLS OF GOD'S WRATH

1 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go, pour out the seven bowls of God's wrath on the earth."

2 The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the land, and ugly, festering sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.

3 The second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it turned into blood like that of a dead person, and

every living thing in the sea died.

4The third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood.

5Then I heard the angel in charge of the waters say: “You are just in these judgments, O Holy One, you who are and who were;

6for they have shed the blood of your holy people and your prophets, and you have given them blood to drink as they deserve.”

7And I heard the altar respond: “Yes, Lord God Almighty, true and just are your judgments.”

8The fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and the sun was allowed to scorch people with fire.

9They were seared by the intense heat and they cursed the name of God, who had control over these plagues, but they refused to repent and glorify him.

10The fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues in agony

11and cursed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, but they refused to repent of what they had done.

12The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up to prepare the way for the kings from the East.

13 Then I saw three impure spirits that looked like frogs; they came out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

14 They are demonic spirits that perform signs, and they go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them for the battle on the great day of God Almighty.

15 “Look, I come like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake and remains clothed, so as not to go naked and be shamefully exposed.”

16 Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon.

17The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and out of the temple came a loud voice from the throne, saying, “It is done!”

18Then there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder and a severe earthquake. No earthquake like it has ever occurred since mankind has been on earth, so tremendous was the quake.

19The great city split into three parts, and the cities of the nations collapsed. God remembered Babylon the Great and gave her the cup filled with the wine of the fury of his wrath.

20Every island fled away and the mountains could not be found.

21From the sky huge hailstones, each

weighing about a hundred pounds, fell on people. And they cursed God on account of the plague of hail, because the plague was so terrible.

REVELATION 20

THE THOUSAND YEARS

1And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain.

2He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or Satan, and bound him for a thousand years.

3He threw him into the Abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore until the thousand years

were ended. After that, he must be set free for a short time.

4I saw thrones on which were seated those who had been given authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony about Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

5(The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection.

6Blessed and holy are those who share in the first resurrection. The

second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.

THE JUDGMENT OF SATAN

7When the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth—Gog and Magog—and to gather them for battle. In number they are like the sand on the seashore.

9They marched across the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of God's people, the city he loves. But fire came down from heaven and devoured them.

10And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

THE JUDGMENT OF THE DEAD

11Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them.

12And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as

recorded in the books.

13The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them, and each person was judged according to what they had done.

14Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. The lake of fire is the second death.

15Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

REVELATION 21

A NEW HEAVEN AND A NEW EARTH

1Then I saw “a new heaven and a new earth,” for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and

there was no longer any sea.

2I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

3And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Look! God’s dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.

4‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’ or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”

5He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!”

Then he said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.”

6He said to me: “It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life.

7Those who are victorious will inherit all this, and I will be their God and they will be my children.

8But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.”

THE NEW JERUSALEM, THE BRIDE OF THE LAMB

9One of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and said to me, “Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.”

10And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God.

11It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

12It had a great, high wall with

twelve gates, and with twelve angels at the gates. On the gates were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel.

13There were three gates on the east, three on the north, three on the south and three on the west.

14The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

15The angel who talked with me had a measuring rod of gold to measure the city, its gates and its walls.

16The city was laid out like a square, as long as it was wide. He measured the city with the rod and found it to

be 12,000 stadia in length, and as wide and high as it is long.

17The angel measured the wall using human measurement, and it was 144 cubits thick.

18The wall was made of jasper, and the city of pure gold, as pure as glass.

19The foundations of the city walls were decorated with every kind of precious stone. The first foundation was jasper, the second sapphire, the third agate, the fourth emerald,

20the fifth onyx, the sixth ruby, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth turquoise, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth

amethyst.

21The twelve gates were twelve pearls, each gate made of a single pearl. The great street of the city was of gold, as pure as transparent glass.

22I did not see a temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.

23The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp.

24The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their splendor into it.

25On no day will its gates ever be

shut, for there will be no night there.

26The glory and honor of the nations will be brought into it.

27Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

REVELATION 22

EDEN RESTORED

1Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb

2down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve

crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.

3No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him.

4They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads.

5There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign for ever and ever.

JOHN AND THE ANGEL

6The angel said to me, “These words are trustworthy and true. The Lord,

the God who inspires the prophets, sent his angel to show his servants the things that must soon take place.”

7“Look, I am coming soon! Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy written in this scroll.”

8I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I had heard and seen them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who had been showing them to me.

9But he said to me, “Don’t do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your fellow prophets and with all who keep the words of this scroll. Worship God!”

10 Then he told me, “Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this scroll, because the time is near.

11 Let the one who does wrong continue to do wrong; let the vile person continue to be vile; let the one who does right continue to do right; and let the holy person continue to be holy.”

EPILOGUE: INVITATION AND WARNING

12 “Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done.

13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

14“Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city.

15Outside are the dogs, those who practice magic arts, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idolaters and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

16“I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star.”

17The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let the one who hears say, “Come!” Let the one who is

thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life.

18I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this scroll: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this scroll.

19And if anyone takes words away from this scroll of prophecy, God will take away from that person any share in the tree of life and in the Holy City, which are described in this scroll.

20He who testifies to these things says, “Yes, I am coming soon.”

Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

21The grace of the Lord Jesus be

with God's people. Amen.

ZECHARIAH 14

THE LORD COMES AND REIGNS

1A day of the LORD is coming, Jerusalem, when your possessions will be plundered and divided up within your very walls.

2I will gather all the nations to Jerusalem to fight against it; the city will be captured, the houses ransacked, and the women ravished. Half of the city will go into exile, but the rest of the people will not be taken from the city.

3Then the LORD will go out and fight against those nations, as he fights on a day of battle.

4On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two from east to west, forming a great valley, with half of the mountain moving north and half moving south.

5You will flee by my mountain valley, for it will extend to Azel. You will flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the LORD my God will come, and all the holy ones with him.

6On that day there will be neither sunlight nor cold, frosty darkness.

7It will be a unique day—a day known only to the LORD—with no distinction

between day and night. When evening comes, there will be light.

8On that day living water will flow out from Jerusalem, half of it east to the Dead Sea and half of it west to the Mediterranean Sea, in summer and in winter.

9The LORD will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one LORD, and his name the only name.

10The whole land, from Geba to Rimmon, south of Jerusalem, will become like the Arabah. But Jerusalem will be raised up high from the Benjamin Gate to the site of the First Gate, to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the

royal wine-presses, and will remain in its place.

11 It will be inhabited; never again will it be destroyed. Jerusalem will be secure.

12 This is the plague with which the LORD will strike all the nations that fought against Jerusalem: Their flesh will rot while they are still standing on their feet, their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongues will rot in their mouths.

13 On that day people will be stricken by the LORD with great panic. They will seize each other by the hand and attack one another.

14 Judah too will fight at Jerusalem.

The wealth of all the surrounding nations will be collected—great quantities of gold and silver and clothing.

15A similar plague will strike the horses and mules, the camels and donkeys, and all the animals in those camps.

16Then the survivors from all the nations that have attacked Jerusalem will go up year after year to worship the King, the LORD Almighty, and to celebrate the Festival of Tabernacles.

17If any of the peoples of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, then LORD Almighty, they

will have no rain.

18If the Egyptian people do not go up and take part, they will have no rain.

The LORD will bring on them the plague he inflicts on the nations that do not go up to celebrate the Festival of Tabernacles.

19This will be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not go up to celebrate the Festival of Tabernacles.

20On that day **HOLY TO THE LORD** will be inscribed on the bells of the horses, and the cooking pots in the **LORD's** house will be like the sacred bowls in front of the altar.

21Every pot in Jerusalem and Judah

will be holy to the LORD Almighty, and all who come to sacrifice will take some of the pots and cook in them. And on that day there will no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the LORD Almighty.

MALACHI 4

JUDGMENT AND COVENANT RENEWAL

1“Surely the day is coming; it will burn like a furnace. All the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble, and the day that is coming will set them on fire,” says the LORD Almighty. “Not a root or a branch will be left to them.

2But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise

with healing in its wings. And you will go out and grow fat like well-fed calves.

3Then you will trample on the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I act,” says the LORD Almighty.

4“Remember the law of my servant Moses, the decrees and laws I gave him at Horeb for all Israel.

5“See, I will send the prophet Elijah to you before that great and dreadful day of the LORD comes.

6He will turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents; or else I will come and strike

the land with total destruction.”

ISAIAH 31

WOE TO THOSE WHO RELY ON EGYPT

1Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, who rely on horses, who trust in the multitude of their chariots and in the great strength of their horsemen, but do not look to the Holy One of Israel, or seek help from the LORD.

2Yet he too is wise and can bring disaster; he does not take back his words. He will rise up against that wicked nation, against those who help evildoers.

3But the Egyptians are mere mortals and not God; their horses are flesh

and not spirit. When the LORD stretches out his hand, those who help will stumble, those who are helped will fall; all will perish together.

4This is what the LORD says to me:

“As a lion growls, a great lion over its prey—and though a whole band of shepherds is called together against it, it is not frightened by their shouts or disturbed by their clamor—so the LORD Almighty will come down to do battle on Mount Zion and on its heights.

5Like birds hovering overhead, the LORD Almighty will shield Jerusalem; he will shield it and deliver it, he will ‘pass over’ it and will rescue it.”

6Return, you Israelites, to the One you have so greatly revolted against.

7For in that day every one of you will reject the idols of silver and gold your sinful hands have made.

8“Assyria will fall by no human sword; a sword, not of mortals, will devour them. They will flee before the sword and their young men will be put to forced labor.

9Their stronghold will fall because of terror; at the sight of the battle standard their commanders will panic,” declares the LORD, whose fire is in Zion, whose furnace is in Jerusalem.

ISAIAH 32

1See, a king will reign in

righteousness and rulers will rule with justice.

2Each one will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm, like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land.

3Then the eyes of those who see will no longer be closed, and the ears of those who hear will listen.

4The fearful heart will know and understand, and the stammering tongue will be fluent and clear.

5No longer will the fool be called noble nor the scoundrel be highly respected.

6For fools speak folly, their hearts

are bent on evil: They practice ungodliness and spread error concerning the LORD; the hungry they leave empty and from the thirsty they withhold water.

7Scoundrels use wicked methods, they make up evil schemes to destroy the poor with lies, even when the plea of the needy is just.

8But the noble make noble plans, and by noble deeds they stand.

9You women who are so complacent, rise up and listen to me; you daughters who feel secure, hear what I have to say!

10In little more than a year you who feel secure will tremble; the grape harvest will fail, and the harvest of

fruit will not come.

**11 Tremble, you complacent women;
shudder, you daughters who feel
secure! Strip off your fine clothes and
wrap yourselves in rags.**

**12 Beat your breasts for the pleasant
fields, for the fruitful vines**

**13 and for the land of my people,
a land overgrown with thorns and
briers—yes, mourn for all houses of
merriment and for this city of revelry.**

**14 The fortress will be abandoned,
the noisy city deserted; citadel and
watchtower will become a wasteland
forever, the delight of donkeys, a
pasture for flocks,**

**15 till the Spirit is poured on us from
on high, and the desert becomes a**

fertile field, and the fertile field seems like a forest.

16The LORD's justice will dwell in the desert, his righteousness live in the fertile field.

17The fruit of that righteousness will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence forever.

18My people will live in peaceful dwelling places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.

19Though hail flattens the forest and the city is leveled completely,

20how blessed you will be, sowing your seed by every stream, and letting your cattle and donkeys range free.

GOD'S LOVE

ISAIAH 40

28 Do you not know?

Have you not heard?

The LORD is the everlasting God,
the Creator of the ends of the earth.
He will not grow tired or weary,
and his understanding no one can
fathom.

29 He gives strength to the weary
and increases the power of the weak.

30 Even youths grow tired and weary,
and young men stumble and fall;

31 but those who hope in the LORD
will renew their strength.

They will soar on wings like eagles;
they will run and not grow weary,
they will walk and not be faint.

ISAIAH 32

16The LORD's justice will dwell in the desert,

his righteousness live in the fertile field.

17The fruit of that righteousness will be peace;

its effect will be quietness and confidence forever.

18My people will live in peaceful dwelling places,

in secure homes,

in undisturbed places of rest.

19Though hail flattens the forest and the city is leveled completely,

20how blessed you will be, sowing your seed by every stream, and letting your cattle and donkeys range

free.

ISAIAH 51

3The LORD will surely comfort Zion and will look with compassion on all her ruins;

he will make her deserts like Eden, her wastelands like the garden of the LORD.

Joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the sound of singing.

4“Listen to me, my people;

hear me, my nation:

Instruction will go out from me;

my justice will become a light to the nations.

5My righteousness draws near speedily,

**my salvation is on the way,
and my arm will bring justice to the
nations.**

**The islands will look to me and wait
in hope for my arm.**

**6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens,
look at the earth beneath;
the heavens will vanish like smoke,
the earth will wear out like a garment
and its inhabitants die like flies.**

**But my salvation will last forever,
my righteousness will never fail.**

**7“Hear me, you who know what is
right,**

**you people who have taken my
instruction to heart:**

**Do not fear the reproach of mere
mortals or be terrified by their**

insults.

8For the moth will eat them up like a garment;

the worm will devour them like wool.

But my righteousness will last forever,

my salvation through all generations.”

ISAIAH 53

2He grew up before him like a tender shoot,

and like a root out of dry ground.

He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him,

nothing in his appearance that we should desire him.

3He was despised and rejected by

mankind,

a man of suffering, and familiar with pain.

Like one from whom people hide their faces

he was despised, and we held him in low esteem.

4 Surely he took up our pain

and bore our suffering,

yet we considered him punished by God,

stricken by him, and afflicted.

5 But he was pierced for our transgressions,

he was crushed for our iniquities;

the punishment that brought us

peace was on him,

and by his wounds we are healed.

6We all, like sheep, have gone astray,
each of us has turned to our own
way;

and the LORD has laid on him
the iniquity of us all.

7He was oppressed and afflicted,
yet he did not open his mouth;
he was led like a lamb to the
slaughter,
and as a sheep before its shearers is
silent,
so he did not open his mouth.

8By oppression and judgment he was
taken away.

Yet who of his generation protested?
For he was cut off from the land of
the living;

for the transgression of my people he was punished.

9 He was assigned a grave with the wicked,

and with the rich in his death,

though he had done no violence,

nor was any deceit in his mouth.

10 Yet it was the LORD's will to crush him and cause him to suffer,

and though the LORD makes his life an offering for sin,

he will see his offspring and prolong

his days, and the will of the LORD will prosper in his hand.

11 After he has suffered, he will see the light of life and be satisfied;

by his knowledge my righteous

servant will justify many, and he will

bear their iniquities.

12Therefore I will give him a portion
among the great,

**and he will divide the spoils with the
strong,**

**because he poured out his life unto
death,**

**and was numbered with the
transgressors.**

**For he bore the sin of many,
and made intercession for the
transgressors.**

ISAIAH 57

13When you cry out for help,
let your collection of idols save you!
The wind will carry all of them off,
a mere breath will blow them away.

**But whoever takes refuge in me
will inherit the land
and possess my holy mountain.”**

COMFORT FOR THE CONTRITE

14And it will be said:

**“Build up, build up, prepare the road!
Remove the obstacles out of the way
of my people.”**

15For this is what the high and
exalted One says—

**he who lives forever, whose name is
holy:**

**“I live in a high and holy place,
but also with the one who is contrite

In another vision my mom heard a voice saying satellite in prison, so she asked the question where will I get the money to pay for satellite in prison? And the voice replied read Job 38.

2“Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge?”

3Brace yourself like a man;

I will question you,
and you shall answer me.

33Do you know the laws of the heavens?

Can you set up God’s dominion over the earth?

34“Can you raise your voice to the clouds and cover yourself with a

flood of water?

35Do you send the lightning bolts on their way?

Do they report to you, 'Here we are'?

36Who gives the ibis wisdom or gives the rooster understanding?

37Who has the wisdom to count the clouds?

Who can tip over the water jars of the heavens

38when the dust becomes hard and the clods of earth stick together?

39“Do you hunt the prey for the lioness and satisfy the hunger of the lions

40when they crouch in their dens or lie in wait in a thicket?

41 Who provides food for the raven when its young cry out to God and wander about for lack of food? After she read Job 38 she replied who am I to answer this?

In the winter of 2003 we went to New York for a few months, during our time there, we began to go through the Television channels. While changing the channels we saw this channel called **TBN**, and they were talking about satellite in prison, **that's when the vision became clear.** While in New York I received a vision in which I saw a number of people coming to me and I turned them away saying they were all bad. **Then I heard a voice saying do not turn them**

away because you do not know the bad from the good. After a while we moved to Kissimmee Florida, after spending a year in Florida we decided to move back up north. While we were in Florida we forgot all about the visions, and the visions ceased. When we returned the visions continued. The first two visions my mom received were, of us looking for a new apartment, and demons coming from the sky.

In the first vision we got an apartment and it was at the border of Trenton and Ewing. My mom saw herself looking over into a valley and she saw the people of Trenton in the valley just wandering as if they are

lost and could not find their way out. Then she heard a voice saying they are sheep without shepherd. She began to preach to them and they disappeared.

In the second vision my mom and I were going shopping, when we were coming back from shopping we had to go past a church and we saw the elder and some young people cleaning up the outside of the church so we stopped and helped. When the work was completed and we decided to leave, the young people and the little children decided to walk with us because we were all going in the same direction. The young people were walking ahead of us, when

suddenly demons coming from the sky began to engulf the young people, so we took the children and ran back to the church to hide. While inside the church we saw the demons transform into human form and were looking for us, so my mom said I hope the elder have a discerning spirit to know that they are demons.

A few days after the visions we began looking for our new apartment, I decided to get the apartment through a rental agency. The day that we were to see the apartment the agent could not make it so she asked her mother to show it to us instead. After seeing the apartment my mom heard a voice saying tell her the

vision, she refused to tell her the vision. After returning to the place where we were staying she heard the voice again tell her the vision, so she called her and told her the vision about the demons engulfing the youth and described the church to her. She replied that's my church, so she invited my mom to come and visit, when we arrived at the church my mom said it's the same church in the same place as in the vision.

A few days later the agent's mother called and said we got the apartment, before we moved into the apartment the landlord called and said he switched the apartment and gave us another one which was at the

border of Trenton and Ewing.

Three weeks after moving into the apartment one morning a strange thing happened, our CD player began to play the CD that I left in it every morning at exactly 5am, the first song on the CD was there can be miracles if you believe, after the songs ended it stopped. It kept playing every morning until we moved We did not place it on CD mode so how could these songs play at exactly the same time every morning?

In another vision my mom was sleeping and she felt someone shake her and told her to go to the television, so she woke and turned

the television on while still half a sleep. When she turned on the television she saw pastor Parsley preaching and the voice said to her he is the helper. The sermon he was preaching was entitled a place called dwell.

In another vision my mom saw pastor Parsley come to a church in Trenton, and when he came all the churches opened their doors and began to hold on to all their members. Then she asked what should she do? And the answer was he is the helper! he should get all the pastors together and sanctify them, then the pastors should get all the members and sanctify them.

In another dream my mom saw a man come from prison and came to our house and he said, do you know that the pretties people are in jail?

Then she saw Jan from TBN come to Trenton with every denomination with her. She also saw TD Jakes come to Trenton to speak to the people but the people would not listen to him, so she got angry and told him to leave them alone, then a voice spoke and said give them a little more time.

In another vision a voice spoke to my mom and another young lady that they should go and collect all the young people and take them to the church. When the young people were

collected and brought to the church a lot of demons came with them, my mom got the chance to go through the gate to the church with all her set of young people before the gate was closed. One of the demons escaped and came into the church and the voice said we must say Jesus, so her and the children began to say Jesus and that's what destroyed the demon. When she looked outside she saw all the people that were locked out and the demons were among them.

She also saw that she went to do missionary work inside the city and some men of the city came against her, and the voice said call the Holy Spirit against them. When she called

the Holy Spirit she saw a large hand hitting one of them and they all ran away.

While living at the apartment at the border of Trenton and Ewing I got a vision in which I looked up into the sky and I saw four moons they began to spin in a circular motion then they transformed into what seemed to be lanterns but what ended up being temples, each one fell on the corners of the earth so there were one temple on each of the four corners of the earth.

I then appeared in a hospital in which I saw people lined up I had my right hand up and people passed by, some of the people that passed by

were healed and some turned into ashes. Those that were healed began to dance scream out that they were healed.

Then I was taken to another part of the hospital where I began to speak to a young lady about being saved so that she can save her daughter. I told her that she had to give her life to Jesus so that her daughter can be saved, but she refused and walked away and she and her daughter was lost.

I also saw myself, my son, and my mother, enter one of the temples that fell from the sky and we took our spot. While in the temple I saw people dressed in white working very

fast, I was then told to go to the temple in Trenton. I then was taken to the door of one of the other temple that fell from the sky, as I looked around I saw people drinking and carrying on all while leaning on the side of the temple. I heard the voice say that time is running out probation is closing these doors are open for a short while for the people to come in, when the door closes there will be no more repentance for mankind.

In another one of my visions I saw the Catholic and the Jews sharing one temple together.

I had a vision of an ancient kingdom placed in modern time. I saw in the vision that the kingdom was taken

from its rightful owners God chosen people, and strangers now inhabited the kingdom. I heard Jesus speaking saying that when he die, take his body back to the kingdom and give it to the people that now inhabit the kingdom. And when they accept my body and place it into the kingdom, the strangers which inhabit the kingdom will no longer rule in that kingdom. Power to inhabit and rule that kingdom will be handed back over to its rightful owners God chosen people. Before I could tell my mother about the vision, she said that she got these words for Israel.

ZECHARIAH 1 14-17

14 So the angel that communed with

me said unto me, Cry thou, saying, Thus saith the Lord of hosts; I am jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great jealousy.

15And I am very sore displeased with the heathen that are at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

16Therefore thus saith the Lord; I am returned to Jerusalem with mercies: my house shall be built in it, saith the Lord of hosts, and a line shall be stretched forth upon Jerusalem.

17Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the Lord of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the Lord shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem

ZECHARIAH 2:10

In another vision my mother saw Shiloh church in Trenton and the Mount Siani Seventh Day Adventist Church united for a day of prayer and a lot of people were going in to pray. This vision made us understand how very important prayer and unity is for our community, united we stand divided we fall.

In another vision my mom was standing in downtown Trenton she looked up into the sky and saw

people standing in midair, she thought they were demons, and she began to shout demon's, then one of them flew down and she realized that they were angels, the angel then said to her give God the praise. God is slow to anger and plenteous in mercy. I know he loves Trenton with a special love, these words were given to my mom for Trenton if they will seek the Lord in prayer for help he will fulfill these promises.

OH MOUNTAINS

Thus said the Lord God because the enemy has said of you, aha the ancient heights have become our possession. Therefore prophecy and say thus says the Lord God. Because

they made you desolate and swallow you up on every side so that you became the possession of the rest of the nations, and you are taken up by the lips of talkers and slandered by the people. Therefore thou mountains hear the word of the Lord God, thus says the Lord God to the mountains, the hills, the rivers, the valleys, the desolate waste, and the cities that have been forsaken; which became plunder and mockery to the rest of the nations all around. Therefore thus says the Lord God surely I have spoken in my burning jealousy against the rest of the nations who gave my lands to themselves as a possession, with whole heart-ed joy and spiteful minds in order to plunder

its open country. Therefore prophecy concerning the land, and say to the mountains, the hills, the rivers, and the valleys. Thus says the Lord God behold I have spoken in my jealousy, and my fury because you have borne the shame of the nations. Therefore thus says the Lord God I have raised my hand in an oath, surely the nations that are around you shall bear their own shame, but you o mountain you shall shoot forth your branches and yield your fruit to my people. For they are about to come, for I indeed I am for you and I will turn to you and you shall be till and sown. I will multiply men upon you all of it, and the cities shall be inhabited and the ruins be rebuilt. I will

multiply upon you man and beast and they shall increase and bear young. I will make you inhabited as in the former times and do better for you than at the beginnings, then you shall know that I am the Lord.

recognize they came together for a building project. She then saw Pat Robinson arrive and said to the pastors, what is the price for the building? So they told him a price that was not the right amount that they needed for the project, so he told them that is not the right price, and he then said do you know that I have people in high places? So they told him the right price and he said yes that's the price.

In another vision I saw a black horse attached to a chariot in midair flying over the city of Trenton.

I also saw many Scorpions in the sky preparing to attack the earth. Soldiers dressed in army attire with battle gear were preparing for the

attack.

Back in 2008 I had a vision about 2012 in which I saw myself in an intense fight with a female demon after I defeated the demon, I walked up the stairs of the underground tomb that I was fighting in. When I reached ground level I saw creatures that had bright colors and furs walking on the earth. I also saw a witch that flew trying to take two human beings off their porch. I saw no humans other than the ones that I saw being taken by the witch, so when I saw a man outside I ran to him and went into his home I then sat down on the couch in his living room, I looked up and saw CNN and the reporter said it is the year 2012.

If I had taken this vision seriously I would have been more prepared for what was soon to come upon me.

Not long after I had another vision where I saw myself and a few others dressed in all black, we were under a pyramid and the pyramid shifted suddenly without warning, I yelled for everyone to run we began to run for our lives before the pyramid crushed us, we all escaped.

When I received the vision about 2012 I did not quite understand it, so I did not take it seriously. 2012 hit me like a tsunami, swift, brutal, and without warning.

I went to work one morning and my boss who was a long time enemy,

because he wanted me to work on the day I worshiped which was not a requirement when I got hired, so he sent text messages to everyone except for those who did not work on the weekends, stating that whoever did not work on the weekend will be fired. So on this particular day I went on the assignment that he scheduled me for, which was not my original post and far from the area which I worked.

While at the post he called another employee to tell me to leave and that I should take off all my equipment right then and give it to him.

He did not even stop there he also lied to unemployment which caused

me great distress and delay and reduction in my unemployment benefit. That situation caused me to lose everything I owned because it took me months before I received my unemployment benefit, and when I did receive it they reduced it from \$244 a week to \$80 dollars a week. At that time I also had a weekend job but it was not in bus route, I had just moved to a new apartment in PA because in a vision my mom saw Jan Crouch the owner of TBN come to our home but she would not come in because she said our house was too small. Then she also saw a man from prison come and said our house is too hot he can not stay, then she heard a

voice say move to the border. Then she asked the question which border?

The voice said Morrisville PA. After moving to Morrisville she saw Jan Crouch visit our new apartment with the Gators, even though we did not understand we obeyed the voice that spoke.

During the time of our tribulation we heard the voice say go get Jan Crouch, but I could not move immediately because I had to change my car registration.

When I contacted my finance company telling them that they had to send the title to the PA registration office so that I could get

the car registered in the state of PA they said they would not send the title and my NJ registration was due to expire in a few days.

Because of that situation I lost my weekend job. I applied for many jobs but there was none in bus route. After suffering for a long time my mom had a vision, in the vision she was passing by a church and she heard a pastor praying intensely as if he was in great distress, and the voice said his name is pastor Zachery Tims, then someone came from the congregation and told her that we will be released in three days.

In exactly three days the finance company called and said they would

send the title. After receiving the car registration, I just got up one day and started to drive and I ended up in Orlando Florida in search of Jan.

We did not know much about Zachery Tims so we did a search on him, that's when we found out he had died. Then my mom remembered a vision she had received where the voice said are you going to wait until they all die off.

We were shaken up, for his death put us in deep thoughts and assured us that the vision was true, that's when we made it a point to reach Jan.

We went to the Holy Land Experience and spoke to the security

officer and he said she is one of the hardest woman to reach so he gave us the brochure and told us to call the number on it, we called and left a message with her secretary Lindsey. When she called back we told her the reason why we called, she then said that we should write Jan an email letter and she will try her best to forward it to her.

When we did not get a reply we sent a video message, when we did not get a response I applied for a job at the Holy Land Experience in hope of getting a chance to talk to Jan. I was very qualified for the position that was open but no one got back to me. I also tried applying for other

jobs but one night in a vision a man came to me and said you will never get a job in Florida because you did not come here for a job you came to get Jan.

The vision was true I never got a job, when I persisted to get a job that's when they came and took my SUV. I decided to get my security license for the state of Florida after finishing and getting my security license I was offered a job from one of the security firms, but one morning at around 3am in the morning I could not sleep so I took a look outside and I did not see my SUV. So I started panicking saying someone stole my SUV so I called the police and they

said that my finance company took my truck. It was not even a full month overdue and they did not even send me a notice to say that they planning to repossess it.

When I called the finance company a lady picked up the phone and told me I better beg for mercy, maybe they might have some mercy on you. So I asked if I could speak to customer service and she said they will have to call me back because they are very busy repossessing other vehicles. When they finally got back to me they said I would have to pay the full amount that I owed in order to get back my SUV.

I then contacted a lawyer to see if what they were doing to me was right, and the lawyer said no it was not right what they did but in order for me to get back my truck I would have to pay them \$5000 dollars, and I would have to return back to New Jersey to fight them. I did not get the job due to losing my only transportation to get to the job. A few weeks later they sold my truck and told me I had to pay the difference.

After a while I decided to go to school, when unemployment found out I was in school they took a way the \$80 and left me with nothing. I have been working since I was 16 and never received any

unemployment benefit until 2012, and all they said they were giving me is \$80 dollars a week.

I had to drop out of school to get back my \$80 dollars unemployment benefit which went to my rent, which cost \$60 dollars a week, then my landlord decided to raise my rent to \$80 dollars a week.

The spirit of God told me to call unemployment so when I called I got someone from a different unemployment office, she fixed my case and gave me \$144 a week that's what saved us, God is truly good.

While spending much of my time home with little to do the voice that always spoke said teach love and

prophecy.

One day we went shopping in August of 2012 at a Walmart store in Orlando, and my mom heard a voice saying go up to the dollar store, so she said what am I going to the dollar store for? But she obeyed the voice and went. She said while she was standing there she saw pastor Johnathan Mcknight coming out of the dollar store with a lot of disposable utensils, she recognized him from TBN. She said that the voice told her to speak to him but she froze

and did not speak to him. Then she saw him leave in a van with a young man driving it. My mom told me what had happened and I decided to find his church so that we could speak to him, so I called his church to get a ride due to not having any transportation of my own.

His secretary said that their van was down so she could not pick us up after trying on more than one occasion to reach him or Jan we decided to head back up north, so the night before we left we went by the church to see pastor Johnathan, in hope that we could speak to him after the service, but immediately after the service he vacated to his

chambers, we then spoke to his security that was guarding the door and asked if we could speak to him because it is very important that we do so because that is the reason why we came, he then told us that we had to make an appointment, when we told him that it was not possible for us to make an appointment seeing we are leaving tomorrow, he refused for us to see him so we left.

After spending one year in Florida I returned back to New Jersey in March of 2013. With God you are never alone. During the time of our distress my mom saw Jesus in a vision come in the midnight hour when it was very dark and he smiled

and his smile lit up the whole place. Though it was a rough journey the mighty hand of God came through protected and provided for us, he is the reason we are standing today.
